While Kendra D'Ercole was pursuing her
doctorate in Music at Arizona State University, she won a composition
competition. The performance of that piece was where she met CSO
Music Director Kayoko Dan who conducted the orchestra for her
winning composition. The piece the CSO will premiere was inspired by
Beethoven's letters to his brothers (and possibly the community at
large) as his deafness increased. The title to Kendra's piece was
borrowed from the postscript to this letter - "As the autumn leaves fall
and wither, so also has [hope] become dried up for me." Kendra will
present the background for her composition and tell us about her
process and experiences at the next Composers Lunch:
